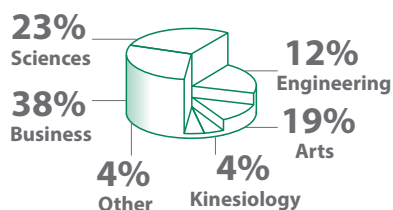
Expand your career options

Full- or part-time options

The Edwards MBA is offered in both full-time and part-time options. If you are looking to fast track your MBA, you can complete the full-time program in only 12 months! Alternatively, the two and three year program options are the perfect solution for those students who are working full time.

What will I study?

MBA courses are scheduled in three week blocks creating an intensive learning environment that immerses students in the subject area while allowing flexibility for personal schedules.

Classes are offered from 4:00-8:00PM on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. There is also one Saturday class scheduled from 9:00-4:30PM in each class block.

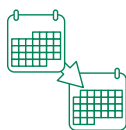

Internship

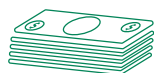
The Edwards MBA Internship Program (EMIP) is an eight month work experience program taken in January of the first year of a two year program of study. It is designed for students with little or no work experience. Students pursuing the internship option must agree to complete their MBA in two years.

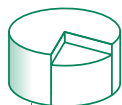

Admission Requirements

- Four-year undergraduate degree, or equivalent, from a recognized college or university with a cumulative weighted average of at least 70% in the last two years of study (i.e. 60 credit units). Applicants with three-year degrees may be considered for admission.
- GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test): Recommended Minimum score of 550 (waiver options available).
- Three confidential letters of recommendation (must include at least one academic and one professional).
- Resume detailing positions held and a description of responsibilities
- Letter of intent describing future career plans related to achieving an Edwards MBA
- Proof of English proficiency – applicants whose first language is not English must provide proof of proficiency in English.

How to Apply

Complete the online application form, including payment of the application fee, available on our website at edwardsmba.ca. Once your application and fee have been received, we will contact you to let you know the next steps.

Deadline for Application

- March 31 – International applicants
- May 31 – Domestic applicants

The Edwards MBA starts in September each year. Applicants wanting to be considered for funding must have their application completed by May 31 (includes all required documents uploaded and letters of reference received.) Applicants are accepted on a rolling basis – so apply early!
