Our Master of Professional Accounting (MPAcc) program is designed for high-achieving accounting students who are seeking an accounting designation and a Master's degree. We offer a comprehensive accounting education in a supportive classroom environment. Students graduate with a competitive advantage as business professionals.



This program is CPA accredited. MPAcc students are exempt from the Foundational Development module and examination. Upon completion of the program, graduates will be eligible to sit for the CPA Core and CPA Leadership Professional Final Exams.

What Will I Study?

Students enrolled in the MPAcc program take classes that prepare them for the CPA Professional Exams and their future career as a Chartered Professional Accountant. Courses are delivered in-person over two consecutive summers from May through August. Students complete 2-3 courses at a time for the duration of summer in both years.

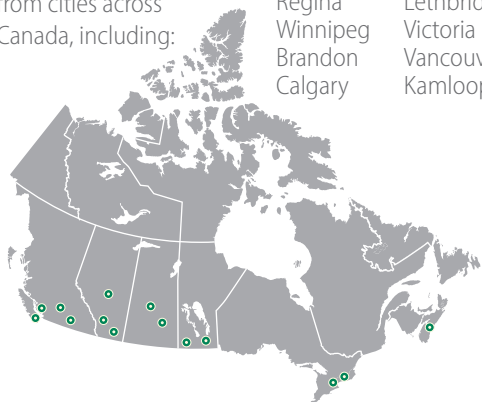
The MPAcc Classroom

Admission Requirements

- A four-year degree or equivalent from a recognized college or university, with a cumulative weighted average of at least 70% in the most recent two years of study (i.e. 60 credit units).
- Adequate preparation in Canadian accounting principles, as demonstrated by successful completion of the appropriate university-level prerequisite courses as designated by the Chartered Professional Accountants of Canada for entrance into the CPA Professional Program.
- Three letters of recommendation, with at least two being academic references.
- Proof of English proficiency. Applicants whose first language is not English must provide proof of language proficiency.
- Up-to-date CV/resume. Preference will be given to applicants with at least four months of CPA practical work experience prior to the start of MPAcc.

How to Apply

Visit edwardsmppacc.ca and complete the online application form, including payment of the application fee. Once your application and fee have been received, you will be able to upload your application documents.

Deadline for Application

Admissions occurs on a rolling basis, so students are accepted into the MPAcc program until it is full. The admission deadline for the Spring intake is November 30 of the previous year. It is best to apply early if you are interested!
