Are you interested in creating a personalized award?

An Edwards education has the power to change lives. However, many students face financial or geographic barriers that limit their access to education. Your support helps remove those obstacles, empowering students to pursue their educational goals without delay. By creating a personalized student award, you make a lasting impact. This requires an annual commitment of \$5,000 or more over three years.

Awards types include:

- Scholarships: awarded based on academic excellence.
- Bursaries: granted in response to demonstrated financial need.
- Prizes: given in recognition of outstanding performance in a particular initiative or activity.

Awards eligibility criteria:

- B.Comm. student
- Second year and up
- Full-time student (taking at least 6 classes per year, 3 per term)
- Minimum average of 70.00% (based on classes taken from September through April)

Examples of more detailed criteria:

- Involvement in community/volunteerism-based activities
- Is a Huskie athlete
- Has dependent(s)
- High academic achievements

Award application timeline:

Spring

- Applications open in March and close in June.
- Gift to be made by January.

Fall

- Applications open September 1 and close October 1.
- Gift to be made by June.
- Exclusively bursaries, students must complete financial need calculator.
